
President Grannemann requested that retiring officers pass their files on to the new officers.


Alan Bailey announced the MML Newly Elected Officials Conference would be held on June 4 and 5 at the Ramada Inn, Jefferson City, Missouri.


NEW BUSINESS


NEW BUSINESS
